

NEW POLICY

Selection of Two 'B' Teams:

B Team coaches will be announced after the selection of the A Team. All candidates for B Team coaches are encouraged to participate and help with tryouts. A Team coaches are required to be stewards of their respective grade, and take an active interest in the placement of players on the B Teams.

Once the A Team is selected and B Team coaches have been announced, the B Team draft can take place. Each B Team coach is allowed to select two assistant coaches prior to the draft. The head coach's child and the assistant coaches' children (up to 3 children total) are then 'reserved' for their respective team and are removed from draft eligibility. Draft order will then be decided by the flip of a coin. The coach winning the coin flip will then be allowed first selection. The other coach will make the second selection. The draft will then continue on a one-for-one basis until all remaining players are placed on a team.

If only one B team Coach is identified prior to the draft, the A team coach will select the team without a coach. In this scenario, the A Team coach will pick the first three players available, with the draft proceeding with the other coach with the 4th selection. It will then continue on a one-for-one basis.

Please note:

- An LPYF Board Member will be present at the time of the B Team draft.
- The goal of selecting B teams is to have them balanced as possible.
- There is no recruiting of any type for B teams. Encouraging kids to not participate in tryouts is a form of recruiting.

A violation of this rule will result in immediate termination of coaching duties, as well as possible expulsion of their child from the program with no refund.
